

# Silver Foliage and Effects Botanical Painting Workshop

April 5,6,7, 2019 - Milwaukie, Oregon

Ever wonder how to make the bloom on fruit, or paint very silvery foliage? We will explore creating silver leaves and foliage and painting fruit with bloom. Or maybe you would prefer working on silvery seed pods (e.g. Lunaria) or pussy willows, which also can be covered.

Workshop participants are recommended to bring prepared sketches ready to execute, to allow for more ground to be covered. Details with registration. For those without experience we could start with the basics.

Instructor Jeanne Debons teaches botanical illustration classes at her studio in Bend, Oregon and other venues. She has a Diploma of Botanical Illustration from the English Gardening School in London, and a PhD in Botany and Plant Pathology from Oregon State University. Jeanne utilizes a step-by-step approach enabling participants to progress at their own speed, skill level and objectives for the workshop.

Participants are encouraged to bring silver botanical subjects to complement those that will be provided. Bring materials required for botanical painting including but not limited to hot press paper (at least four 8.5"x11" or 1 22"x30"), water color paints, brushes (I will have a limited quantity available for purchase), magnifying glass (a few mag eyes will be provided for use and/or purchase), your own light source, water pots, paper towels, drawing materials including ruler, pencils, sharpener, erasers (one plastic and one kneadable), tracing paper.



Cost \$180 for 3-day workshop, or \$80 per day
